Media Participation

The media, including, but not limited to radio and television, shall be welcomed at any or all regular, special, or annual meeting of the Board of Education. Video and audio recording is permitted, so long as it is conducted in a manner that is not disruptive or distracting to the conduct of the meeting.

1.1 Equipment used may not produce distracting light or sound emission.

1.2 Any video or audio recording devices shall be placed in a manner in order that they will not obstruct the public's view of the Board members.

1.3 Video or audio recording devices shall not be placed on the Board member's table. All devices must be placed at least three (3) feet from the table.

Review Schedule

This policy shall replace the previous Monroe County Schools Policy BDDI in its entirety and shall be reviewed in accordance with the Policy Review Schedule published by the Superintendent.
