

Monroe County Athletic Rules and Expectations

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Attendance

Attendance at both school and extracurricular activities are extremely important. Players must attend a minimum of one-half of the school day to participate in practice or games that fall on the same day as the absence. Any exceptions must be approved by the coach, athletic director, and principal.

Behavior

Students participating in extracurricular events are expected to behave in an appropriate manner during and at after school events.

Players who serve In-School-Suspension, for any reason, shall not participate in activities after school on the day(s) of the suspension. Players shall attend practice or games but will not be allowed to participate.

Players who serve Out-of-School Suspension, for any reason, shall not participate in activities after school on the day(s) of the suspension. This includes practice and games. If the day(s) of out-of-school suspension do not fall on a day of a game, the player will set out the next game, following the suspension.

A second, separate offense that results in Out-of-School Suspension, for any reason, will result in removal from the team.

Team Rules, Expectations, and Contracts

This document serves as the rules and expectations for all extracurricular teams in Monroe County Schools. Coaches have the right to enforce other rules and contracts as they deem necessary for players.
