

BASIC INSTRUCTIONAL PROGRAM

A basic educational program, sequentially developed, is provided to serve the needs of a large urban community.

It is the policy of the Monroe County Schools that there be a basic curriculum to provide for the intellectual growth of all pupils, kindergarten through the 12th year, so developed that learning experiences and achievement may vary according to individual needs, and give all pupils a basic body of understandings, attitudes, and knowledge needed for living in a democracy.

This policy will insure that students have the opportunity to develop intellectual curiosity, critical thinking, problem-solving abilities, and aesthetic appreciation in the school years in such a manner that they will be used throughout a lifetime.

It is also the policy of Monroe County Schools that a high priority must be given to those kinds of learning which serve as a foundation for other educational development. These include: English language, mathematics, social studies, science, music, art, and health and physical education.
