

FEDERAL GOVERNMENT RELATIONS

- 1.0 The Federal Government has made available to the local school board many and varied programs related to education. The Board approves participating in those programs for which our school system has need and from which pupils can profit educationally. The Board will follow all federal guidelines established for these programs; however, the Board will work through our representatives in Congress to change guidelines when needed and to pass needed federal legislation pertaining to the successful operation of the public schools.

- 2.0 The Board of Education of Monroe County agrees to comply with Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964 (Public Law 88-352) and all requirements imposed by or pursuant to the regulations of the Department of Health, Education and Welfare affecting federal programs in which Monroe County is participating. The Board agrees to the regulation that, no person in the United States, shall on the grounds of race, color, or national origin be excluded from participating in, be denied the benefit of, or be otherwise subjected to discrimination under any program or activity of the Monroe County Public Schools.
