

STUDENT AUTOMOBILE AND MOTORCYCLE USE

Pupils driving automobiles or motorcycles to school shall park them in the area or areas designated by the principal. Because of the potential danger to walking pupils, the crowded conditions in the area of the schools, and the increased temptation to skip, pupils shall not be allowed to drive or sit in their automobiles during school hours, including the noon hour. Automobiles driven by pupils are to be viewed in the same manner as a school bus. That is, they may be used to transport a pupil from his home to school and back home, but are not to be used for pleasure riding at any time during the school day.

If regulations set up for pupils who bring their automobiles to school are abused, the school has the right to discontinue the privilege of the pupil to bring his/her car onto school grounds.
