

STUDENT PSYCHOLOGICAL SERVICES

- 1.0 Special psychological testing and counseling shall be made available to all students enrolled in the schools. Due to limited availability of a trained psychologist, this service will, by necessity, be limited to those cases with the greatest need. Future plans call for expansion of this service as funds become available.
- 2.0 Psychological testing will be administered by qualified persons upon recommendation of the teacher and principal with approval of the director of special education. In addition, parental consent shall be solicited; however, the Superintendent may authorize such testing, if in best interests of the student, without parent consent.
- 3.0 The results of all psychological testing shall be confidential by members of the professional staff; however, records of same will be made available to parents upon request. It is recommended that the psychologist, special education director or qualified teacher explain to the parent the significance of the results.
