

TRANSFER OF PUPILS FROM MONROE COUNTY TO ANOTHER SCHOOL DISTRICT

Monroe County Board of Education provides an excellent school system as possible and meets all standards as directed by State Law and State Board Policy.

All students living in Monroe County and in a Monroe County School zone are required to attend Monroe County Schools with the following exceptions.

1. A student may be permitted to attend adjoining county if said county offers a program of study or a special program that is not offered in Monroe County. Permission will not be granted for convenience only. This must be agreed upon by both counties involved. County board minutes shall reflect same.
2. Any pupil attending a school in a district adjacent to the pupil's district of residence during the 1984-85 school year is authorized to continue such attendance, and upon written request by the parent or guardian, any person who is entitled to attend public schools of this state and who resides in the same household and is a member of the immediate family of such pupil is also authorized to enroll in such adjacent district. (House Bill 1437 - July 12, 1985)
3. Any parent that contests the above statements shall have a right to appear before the board and request on an individual basis to transfer their children to another school district.
