

Weighted Grades at High School

- I. In order to meet the requirements of WB State Board Policy 2510, beginning with the 2018-2019 school year, students taking Advanced Placement, Honors, Dual Credit or Project Lead the Way classes would have their final average weighted in order to reflect the academic rigor of these classes.
- II. The following weight would be added to their yearly average for Advanced Placement Dual Credit and Project Lead the Way courses beginning with the 2018-2019 freshman cohort:

- III. The weight would be added to the student's yearly average provided that the student took the test for the class.
- IV. This weighted average would be used as part of the consideration for graduation honors.

The following weight would be added to their yearly average for Honors courses beginning with the 2018-2019 freshman cohort:
